EEA Core Set of Indicators - CSI 030 Renewable energy consumption May 2005 assessment

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Key policy question: Are we switching to renewable energy sources to meet our energy consumption?

Key message: The share of renewable energies in total energy consumption increased over the period 1990-2002, but still remains at a low level. Significant further growth will be needed to meet the EU indicative target of a 12 % share by 2010.
